RUGGERI PROSECCO 'ARCEO' DOC NV

Veneto, Italy 13 / 62

Delicate aromas and flavours of apple, sweet pear, citrus and nectarine with a silky, vibrant dry finish.

POL ROGER RESERVE BRUT CHAMPAGNE NV

Champagne, France 25 / 149

With a rich heritage of excellence spanning five generations, Pol Roger's uncompromising reputation for quality is evident in every stunning mouthful. So too is that persistent mousse of small bubbles distinguishing feature attributed to some of Champagne's coolest and deepest cellars. Capturing the elegance of the Chardonnay grape, the Pinot Noir structure and Pinot Meunier fruitiness, Pol Roger is sublimely well balanced. It's a rich, textured, dry, mid-weight. It makes a great accompaniment to seafood mollusks, such as oysters, mussels or clams. Drinks best with that special loved one.

ROSÉ

FAMILLE PERRIN RESERVE COTES DU RHONE ROSÉ 2021

Cotes du Rhone, France 14 / 66

The grapes are harvested early in the morning to benefit from the freshness of the night. The proximity of the vines to the Grand Prébois cellars allows the grapes to be pressed straight after picking. After pressing, the juices are cold settled in order to remove suspended particles. Cinsault, Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah. Finesse, delicate, well balanced, nice minerality and a saline character

W H I T E W I N E

JIM BARRY “THE ATHERLEY” RIESLING 2021 *Clara Valley, SA* 12 / 55

This wine is a pale straw colour in the glass. The nose has a vibrant lift of punchy lemon sherbet, orange blossom and freshly grated ginger. A wine of great line and drive, the palate has lashings of flavours with elements of lemon curd, lime, grapefruit, guava and nashi pear. The wine finishes with a gentle touch of mineralic texture to round out a mouth-watering Riesling.

TENUTA MACCAN PINOT GRIGIO
FRIULI GRAVE DOC 2020 *Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy* 14 / 66

A lovely, ripe style of Pinot Grigio, pale lemon in colour with aromas of peaches, pears and blossom on the nose. The palate has a slightly creamy texture with notes of ripe apples, lemon rind and fleshy stone fruits, balanced perfectly by a fresh acidity.

FONDO ANTICO GRILLO 2020 *Sicilia, Italy* 15 / 69

Shining and lively, of yellow color with green glares. Its bouquet, spouse the delicacy of the flowers to the sweetness of the white fruit giving voice to the Speaking Cricket that it reveals therefore the scents of the grape. Freshness is accompanied to the palate from good sapidity. Balanced aim testifies the compromise acidity-maturation of the fruit.

WILLIAM FEVRE PETIT CHABLIS 2019 *Chablis, France* 18 / 85

The Petit Chablis was matured in stainless steel vats for a period of 8-10 months to preserve freshness. Bright pale straw colour with a subtle greenish tint to the edges and a watery hue. Pear and lime top notes meld into wet stone, light fresh herb and mineral scents. Delectable pear and lime fruits infused with fresh herbs overlay a stony back drop. Some chalky mineral characters lingering on the dry fresh finish.

BABICH SAUVIGNON BLANC 2020 *Marlborough, NZ* 12 / 55

The bouquet is an inviting mix of tropical, passionfruit aromas with notes of musk and box hedge. Palate entry is luscious and lively, bursting with red current, gooseberry and passionfruit, rounding off with a hint of capsicum.

VASSE FELIX CHARDONNAY 2020 *Margaret River, WA* 15 / 65

Made in the modern Margaret River style of elegance, power and restraint, with the wild complexity which distinguishes Vasse Felix Chardonnay. A subtle fragrance of fresh pineapple curd, crayon wax, cereal, bee pollen and chamomile. Secondary notes of hot wet stone and mushroom contribute a lovely exotic, savoury nuance. Immediately juicy upfront, the fleshy, just-ripe fruit carries lovely fresh acidity and mouth-watering succulence.

GROWERS GATE MOSCATO 2019 *Riverland, SA* 10 / 45

The Growers Gate Moscato combines lifted floral and orange blossom aromas, with a lively palate of rose water, fruit sweetness, good acidity and a touch of spritz.

RED WINE

QUARTIER PINOT NOIR 2020

12 / 55

Initially reserved, the nose opens to reveal engaging fruit aromas of red cherry and brambleberry, with subtle and calming notes of red florals and wood-derived spiciness. Strawberry and raspberry flavours dominate the silky mid-palate, concluding with a juicy finish ably supported by chalky tannins. With its usual attractiveness, the cooler vintage has delivered a prettier and more delicate wine than in previous years.

CANTINA I SODI CHIANTI CLASSICO DOCG 2018

Tuscany, Italy 16 / 77

Red ruby color, initial hints of "mammola" violet typical of Sangiovese. Excellent acidic-tannin balance with a slight aftertaste of wild liquorice.

VIBERTI LANGHE NEBBIOLO DOC 2019

Piedmont, Italy 18 / 85

The wine is then stocked in stainless steel for 9-10 months, later the wine is moved in wood barrel, steamed oak for extra 2-3 months before bottling. Further 3 months in bottle storage before releasing in the market. Dark red fruits with floral notes. Strawberry and cherries on the mid palate with soft and silky tannins and a long savoury finish.

TILIA MALBEC 2020

Mendoza, Argentina 13 / 62

From the heart of Mendoza this Malbec provides some great quality fruit with some spice on the finish. Violets, rich plum marmalade, vanilla oak flavours. Well-structured, persistent, round, silky tannins.

TORZI MATTHEW 'DJ' SHIRAZ 2020

Barossa Valley, SA 12 / 55

Plump full palate will nice rich berry and chocolatey notes on the palate, with creamy fine tannins to finish.

SPARKLING WINE

ROCHFORD ESTATE BLANC DE BLANCS 2019 *Yarra Valley, VIC* 79

Fresh, lemon zesty nose with warm yeasty undertones. A bright, vibrant evolution on the palate with freshly baked bread sweetness shot through with citrus and green apple flavours. Long lasting and elegant.

BILLECART-SALMON BRUT ROSE' *Champagne, France* 209

Champagne Rosé is a true delight to the senses and Billecart-Salmon rightly takes its place in the top echelon. A vibrant Salmon pink colour greets the glass, with a long, smooth, delicate, elegant and refined palate to follow.

POL ROGER VINTAGE BLANC DE BLANCS 2012 *Champagne, France* 249

Pol Roger Blanc de Blancs Vintage 2012 is pale yellow-gold in colour with shimmering reflections, enhanced by a fine and elegant stream of lingering bubbles. This is a champagne bursting with elegance.

RIESLING

PROPSTEI EBERNACH RIESLING QBA TROCKEN 2019 *Mosel, Germany* 77

The nose is characterized by vegetative aromas, full of power and expressiveness, with a charming spice and wonderfully harmonious. An ideal wine for every day, both as a solo actor and as a food companion.

FOREST HILL 'BLOCK 2' RIESLING *Mount Barker, WA* 85

Racy, lip-smacking Riesling from the best sections of old Block 2 vineyard, planted in 1975. Citrus and grapefruit are the fruits to the fore, with some slatey, stony back up. The natural acidity is softened by some judicious lees contact, creating an intense Riesling experience.

PINOT GRIS

STARBOROUGH PINOT GRIS 2021 *Marlborough, NZ* 55
Aromatic stone fruits lifted by exotic florals. Textural palate with pear rose-petal and concentrated dry finish.

QUARTIER PINOT GRIS 2020 *Mornington Peninsula, VIC* 63
Juicy and textural pear and quince flavours are balanced by phenolics and fine acidity. Orchard fruit and orange zest round out the palate.

ITALIAN WHITES

BERTANI SEREOLE SOAVE DOC 2020 *Veneto, Italy* 78
The floral bouquet has overtones of elderflower and pear, developing into ripe aromas of yellow-fleshed fruits such as apricot, pineapple and melon. Plush on the palate, balanced with sapid notes that enhance the structure.

SAN SALVATORE PORCONERO FIANO IGP 2019 *Campania, Italy* 67
It has pear, peach, tropical notes, flinty minerals, crisp acid, light alcohol and long finish.

VARVAGLIONE '12 E MEZZO' MALVASIA
DEL SALENTO IGP 2020 *Puglia, Italy* 60
When the Apulian's sun meets the Malvasia of Salento grapes the result is a wine rich in perfumes and vibrant notes of vanilla. Hints of tropical fruits are mixed with honey and vanilla. The palate is striking for its fresh liveliness and its balance. It is structured, harmonious and persistent, delicate flavour.

SAN MICHELE APPIANO 'SCHULTHAUSER'
PINOT BIANCO DOC 2020 *Trentino Alto Adige, Italy* 89
The most underrated and delicate grape varietal of Northern Italy. The lively acidity combined with a creamy and elegant palate make this wine a perfect aperitif and very versatile when it comes to food pairing.

VILLA SPARINA GAVI DOCG 2016 *Piedmont, Italy* 101
The best white wine varietal of Piedmont, it shows a delicate bouquet of flowers and peach. Full and rich yet delicate on the palate with a style as unique as the bottle shape. Rewarded as "European Winery of the Year 2021."

PRINCIPI DI SPADAFORA CATARRATTO
IGP TERRE SICILIANE 2019 *Sicily, Italy* 59
One of the most ancient Sicilian grape varieties. It shows rich intense dried flowers and apple aromas followed by a lemon, apple and honey palate. Dry and persistent.

OTHER WHITE VARIETALS

- PAUL BLANCK PINOT BLANC 2019 *Alsace, France* 80
Bright pale straw colour with a greenish tinged outskirts and watery hue. Emanating from the glass are lime and green apple scents with some fresh pear and stony mineral notes ensuing. Juicy ripe pear flavours drive the palate with an undercurrent of lightly spiced honeysuckle characters, quince and wet stones. The well rounded mouthfeel showing plenty of flesh. Finishes dry and fresh with a long satisfying aftertaste.
- MARC BREDIF VOUVRAY CHENIN BLANC 2020 *Loire Valley, France* 88
The domaine of Marc Bredif is one of the most famous names in the Loire, renowned for the longevity and quality of his Vouray. The colour is pale gold yellow. Very intense and fruity nose with notes of white flowers and quince. Subtle attack on the palette. Nice Chenin blanc with fresh structure and aromatic finish.
- BODEGAS EIDOSELA
'CHARQUIÑO' ALBARIÑO 2019 *Rías Baixas, Spain* 57
Stainless steel handling, with 50% of the blend aged 4 months on lees in tank. With juicy acidity and a nice little nutty snap to close, the fruit tannins are perfectly handled Prickly pear, small green apples, pomelo, cut white nectarine, preserved lemon, straw, a nice briny tang and lovely bitter herbs: rocket, white pepper, radish, cut fennel.
- LYRARAKIS 'VOILA' ASSYRTIKO 2018 *Crete, Greece* 61
Bright Platinum colour. Complex aromas of citrus and white fleshed fruits with notes of ginger. Marvelously ripe grapes have given this wine a crispy and rich mouthfeel with a mineral and chalky character.
- YALUMBA SAMUEL'S COLLECTION VIOGNIER 2020 *Eden Valley, SA* 64
Yalumba is one of the world's leading Viognier winemakers, and this fine wine is our pure expression of the exotic variety. It's full of flavour and character, but finishes with freshness.

CHARDONNAY

- CASTELLI ESTATE CHARDONNAY 2020 *Pemberton, WA* 61
Generous aromatics of white peach, fresh grapefruit and white flowers. A balance of rich flavour, interwoven oak with an intensely textural, taut mid-palate, fine acidity and exceptional length.
- TOKAR ESTATE 'COLDSTREAM VINEYARD' CHARDONNAY 2019 *Yarra Valley, VIC* 75
With flavours of nectarine, lime and hazelnuts and Balanced by citrus-like acidity and complemented by French oak leaving a long and elegant finish.
- SHADOWFAX MACEDON CHARDONNAY 2019 *Macedon Ranges, VIC* 82
Sourced from some of the highest altitude vineyards of Macedon, this release is full of peach, nougat, lemon and cashew flavours.
- LOUIS MAX BOURGOGNE 'BEAUCCHARME' 2016 *Burgundy, France* 89
Yellow gold brilliant robe, with beautiful green reflections. A nose bursting with fresh fruits aromas, with notes of oaky vanilla, honey and acacia. Full and round in the mouth, with the same fresh fruits flavors, and a lengthy finish.
- DOMAINE LOUIS MICHEL & FILS CHABLIS 2019 *Chablis, France* 123
These vines that are picked for this Louis Michel Chablis are situated in the heart of the historic vineyard. The varying soil dates back to the Kimmeridgian period, with relatively deep clay loam, containing marl and oyster fossils. Quite rich in limestone. Resulting in a wine that has aromas of citrus with steely minerality on the nose, followed by a long deep and crisp finish.
- SEVILLE ESTATE 'RESERVE' CHARDONNAY 2019 *Yarra Valley, VIC* 121
This is 100% Estate grown Chardonnay. A mild start to the growing season with October and November producing some beautifully warm Spring days coupled with good rainfall. This lay the foundation for a great start to the season and a kick start to growth in the vineyard. Mild weather conditions with light winds followed through flowering which meant a high percentage of fruit set was achieved. As a result, this Chardonnay style is crisper, tighter in structure with citrus fruit characters.

R O S É

CAPCANES 'MAS DONIS' ROSAT DE GARNACHA 2019 *Tarragona, Spain* 69

It's everything about the berry but lighter, fresher and zippier. Beautiful red fruits of the forest with an appley crunch, a dash of limestone and delicate fruit tannins buzzing in a herbal register.

TARRAWARRA ESTATE PINOT NOIR ROSE 2019 *Yarra Valley, VIC* 77

The wine shows classic lifted strawberry Pinot Noir aromas. It is a dry, yet succulent wine with fresh acidity and fine texture.

DOMAINE SAINTE-MARIE
CUVEE TRADITION ROSÉ 2019 *Côtes de Provence, France* 85

The hue is a very pale rosé with some nice gold reflects. On the nose emerges some delicate touch of white flowers and small red berries. Clean, soft, pleasant and well balanced, with a salty end.

P I N O T N O I R

- SAN PIETRO PINOT NOIR 2019** *Mornington Peninsula, VIC* 52
Intense varietal characters of berry and forest floor. Round palate balanced with fine, almost creamy tannin finish.
- SANZIANA PINOT NOIR 2019** *Recas, Romania* 62
Gorgeous flavours, almost syrupy in its concentration. Dark, rich and potent, with layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon. Deep, with pretty fruit cake and spicy aromatics. Lingering aftertaste.
- ASTORIA 'CARANTO' PINOT NERO IGT 2020** *Veneto, Italy* 69
Intense and pleasant on the nose reminding aromas of strawberries and raspberries. Gentle and harmonic on the palate with ripe notes of red fruit.
- SEVILLE ESTATE 'SEWN' PINOT NOIR 2019** *Yarra Valley, VIC* 72
A classic example of Yarra Valley Pinot. Medium bodied in weight, the concentrated varietal dark cherry and blueberry flavours are supported by wonderfully sweet well integrated oak.
- RIPOSTE 'SABRE' PINOT NOIR 2017** *Adelaide Hills, SA* 77
The cool-climate of the Adelaide Hills has proven to be a haven for Pinot Noir and is quickly establishing a reputation akin to the benchmark Australian regions. Tim Knappstein from Riposte harnesses the qualities of the region and the varietal with effortless ease with his The Sabre. Bright colour in the glass is followed by a lifted floral nose with a savoury edge. The palate is fresh, clean and superbly powerful. A delight.
- DOMAINE BOUCHARD PÈRE ET FILS
BOURGOGNE PINOT NOIR 2019** *Burgundy, France* 89
Renowned and respected as one of the finest producers in Burgundy, Bouchard Père et Fils has truly become an institution, known for the exceptional quality of their wines and the diversity of its many vineyards. Founded in 1731, Bouchard Père et Fils has built up an estate of 130ha. A pleasantly balanced wine which reveals a harmonious blend of fruit and terroir.
- DOMAINE A PINOT NOIR 2013** *Coal River, Tasmania* 119
It's a classic—the consummate Tasmanian pinot noir. Bright in the glass, the hue is reminiscent of port wine jelly and mulberry, with aromatics of Christmas pudding, black cherry and port-soaked raisins, as well as violet and lilac. The palate is velvety and silken soft with beautifully integrated tannins, structure and impressive acidity providing backbone. Notes of star anise, plum, cranberry and a touch of menthol unite to create an almost blackcurrant pastille-like flavour, and lead to a subtle dark chocolate finish.

Onannon is three people with one goal. The people are Sam Middleton, Kaspar Hermann and Will Byron, each of whom contributed the last letters of their surname to make Onannon. A friendship forged in winemaking studies was cemented in Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, with each of them serving stints at Coldstream Hills in the Yarra Valley in the noughties. Sam and Kaspar are still based in the Yarra, making wine at Mount Mary, while Will works at a winery on the Mornington Peninsula. Their goal at Onannon is to craft wines that speak a little of themselves and a lot of their place. Since starting out in 2008, their focus has been Pinot Noir and the regions of Gippsland and Mornington Peninsula, though in 2012 they added a first Gippsland Chardonnay. This tight band of brothers has garnered a devoted following with bright, expressive wines made in minuscule quantities. They have a great future ahead of them. “You would have to go a long way to find three more open-hearted and utterly committed winemakers; the world is their oyster, their ambitions unlimited.” James Halliday.

ITALIAN REDS

MASSERIA SETTEPORTE ETNA ROSSO DOC 2017 *Sicily, Italy* 89

Impressive and full of personality with a distinct, territorial imprint. When tasting the Nerello Mascalese from Masseria Setteporte one can almost imagine the steep, high altitude vineyards which cling to the slopes of Mount Etna in the red, mineral, volcanic soil of the Biancavilla area. Rustic, mineral, at times even herbal, but with a smooth and generous fruity core.

TENUTA ULISSE MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO DOP 2019 *Abruzzo, Italy* 67

Layers of plum and red cherry aromas, with blueberry, blackcurrant and savoury red fruits. Medium bodied, softly textured and with great fruit intensity.

TENUTA CORTE PAVONE ROSSO DI MONTALCINO DOC 2017 *Tuscany, Italy* 79

Ruby red. Ethereal notes together with violet, forest floor, licorice, plum, spices and tobacco. Lively acidity and strong yet silky tannins. Pleasant final, long, dry and persistent.

SILVIO NARDI BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO DOCG 2016 *Tuscany, Italy* 249

This wine comes from one of the most famous appellations in the world. It shows sophisticated, rich and complex aromas of ripe wild berries, anise and a touch of vanilla. Great structure, length and supple tannins, delicious.

MARCHESI DI BAROLO "TRADIZIONE" BAROLO DOCG 2017 *Piedmont, Italy* 202

This wine is made in the historical castle where over 200 year ago the first bottle of Barolo was born. The aroma is intense and persistent with hints of spices, cinnamon, absinthe, tobacco and wild rose. The taste is full and elegant, with soft tannins. The spicy and the woody aromas blend perfectly.

VARVAGLIONE "PAPALE" PRIMITIVO DI MANDURIA DOP 2017 *Puglia, Italy* 121

A wine that admirably identifies its territory with its important structure and unique aromas, while respecting the elegance that sets it apart. The rich aromas of black currant, blackberries, cherries, cocoa and liquorice leads to a round and soft palate, with a long-lasting aromatic finish.

ASTORIA AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA DOCG 2017 *Veneto, Italy* 119

The most powerful and unique wine style produced in Italy. Complex and spicy, with hints of cinnamon, cherry jam and fruit liqueur. Full-flavoured, with notes of black cherries, vanilla and coffee grounds.

BRICCO MAIOLICA BARBERA D'ALBA DOC 2018 *Piedmont, Italy* 88

This wine is our traditional Barbera, it is refined in steel tanks for 10 months. It's a very fruity wine with sensation of currant, bilberry, black cherry, plum and mulberry. This Barbera very velvety, with little acidity, matches well with easy food (pizza, salami, barbecued meat) and soft unripe cheeses.

FONDO ANTICO 'NENE' NERO D'AVOLA DOC 2019 *Sicily, Italy* 63
This is a very elegant southern Italy variety, one that knows very well the environment where it thrives. Long lasting, fresh and fruity with strong hints of cherry and red fruits. This wine is so pleasant to drink that it is a resourceful all-rounder and goes well with both meat and fish, especially if enriched with Mediterranean spices.

OTHER RED VARIETALS

PIERRE AMADIEU COTES DU RHONE 2018 *Rhone Valley, France* 66
Bunches of Grenache and Syrah grown on chalk and clay soils are strictly sorted to produce this cuvée. Hand harvests and traditional winemaking processes give a wine with red and black fruits aromas (blackberry and plum). A sweet touch of liquorice plus spice add layers to the sumptuous palate. A mouth filling wine in a pure Rhône style.

ROCIM MARIANA TINTO 2019 *Alentejano, Portugal* 72
Deep ruby colour. Mace spice relieves the vanilla and black cherry density you expect here. Fluid, with good presence, but balanced without any sense of heftiness. Soft, dry, shapely, with nice structure, fresh, clean and great value.

EL QUINTANAL TEMPRANILLO JOVEN 2019 *Ribera Del Duero, Spain* 67
'El Quintanal' Tinto Fino ferments in stainless steel tanks for nearly 13-14 days, and 10-12 days maceration. Short period in oak barrels. Purple chery red, intense black and red fruit, violet, and soft liquorice notes. Soft, tasty and round, emphasising aromatic persistence.

DOMINIQUE PIRON BEAUJOLAIS VILLAGES 2019 *Beaujolais, France* 66
Outstanding Gamay from the Piron family - as if we've come to expect anything less! Perfumed and fresh with dark cherry, raspberry, a subtle minerality, dried herbs, and some dusty tannins. Easy to drink and even easier to love.

C A B E R N E T & M E R L O T B L E N D S

- COSTA LAZARIDI AMETHYSTOS ROUGE
(CABERNET SAUVIGNON MERLOT AGIORGITIKO) 2015 *Drama, Greece* 69
The touch of the great “Flying” winemaker Michel Rolland, who consults our estate on red winemaking, leaves a strong impression on our oldest red wine label. Bright and dense, purple red. Well structured bouquet, combining aromas of red forest fruit, cherry jam and spices on a discreet oak background.
- IRVINE ‘ESTATE’ MERLOT 2018 *Eden Valley, SA* 59
Deep, dark red. An expressive nose of summer berries, cherry, black olive and spice. Medium-bodied showing elegance and restraint. Redcurrant, earth and creamy oak with bright acidity and fine chalky tannin.
- BALNAVES CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2016 *Coonawarra, SA* 85
Classic Coonawarra at it’s best, with mint, cassis, earth and vanilla flavours. Excellent structure and finesse.
- CHATEAU DE MALLERET BORDEAUX
HAUT MEDOC CRU BOURGEOIS 2015 *Le Pian-Médoc, France* 101
This wine is rich, with layers of ripe blackberry flavors. Firm tannins are integrated into the luscious fruits and hints of wood aging. This full-bodied, generous wine is sure to mature well.
- PIERRE AMADIEU COTES DU RHONE 2018 *Rhone Valley, France* 66
Bunches of Grenache and Syrah grown on chalk and clay soils are strictly sorted to produce this cuvée. Hand harvests and traditional winemaking processes give a wine with red and black fruits aromas (blackberry and plum). A sweet touch of liquorice plus spice add layers to the sumptuous palate. A mouth filling wine in a pure Rhône style.

SHIRAZ

- KENNEDY 'HENRIETTA' SHIRAZ 2019** *Heathcote, VIC* 55
A firm acid line provides freshness on the palate and allows red fruit, spice and Henrietta's typical richness to be carried by the wine's elegant frame.
- PRINIPI DI SPADAFORA SYRAH IGP** *Sicily, Italy* 66
The Syrah from the renowned organic wine producer Dei Principi di Spadafora is a deep purple red wine made solely from Syrah grapes grown in the hilly area around Monreale to the southwest of Palermo. It is a fine, elegant and mature wine with hints of wild berries and well-balanced tannins.
- INDIGO SHIRAZ 2016** *Beechworth, VIC* 74
The wine is true to the Beechworth medium bodied style with elegant tannins. The colour is a lovely dark crimson. On the nose there is the dark brooding fruit and a powerful middle palate.
- COOPER BURNS SHIRAZ 2019** *Barossa Valley, SA* 82
Intensely flavoured and richly textured palate, packed with black and red fruits and a touch of spice, framed by fine silky tannins, great length and balance.
- JIM BARRY THE MCRAE WOOD SHIRAZ 2017** *Clare Valley, SA* 99
The McRae Wood Label honors the establishment in Clare Valley of Jim's Barry's first Shiraz vineyard. This is an unashamedly old fashion Clare Shiraz. A big wine with cherries, plum and vanilla on the nose and a rich full palate supported by strong oak backbone.
- DOMAINE CLARENDON SYRAH 2013** *Blewitt Springs, SA* 107
Polished and impressively rounded on the palate. Substantial mid palate weight is densely packed with cassis and rose petal notes. There is a framework of muscularity and power however sweet and supple tannins mask any rigidity.
- MITOLO 'G.A.M' SHIRAZ 2017** *McLaren Vale, SA* 112
Savoury, structured and serious palate, packed with black fruits and dried herb. It starts fleshy and smooth, with the tannins building slowly helping to keep the fruit in check.
- GLAETZER AMON RA SHIRAZ 2018** *Barossa Valley, SA* 167
Wine critics have already compared this wine to the world class 2004 vintage rendition of this wine, it's powerful, smooth, seductive and rich with a finish that lasts and lasts.
